

MSS – Pass Crossing 2012

Regulations

01. The purpose of the MSS Pass Crossing is to show the beauty of the Swiss Alps and less known spots of Switzerland to motorcyclists in a touristic competition. MSS awards points of defined Swiss mountain pass routes for each crossing during one season. This is the basis for the annual score.

02. Entitled to participate are motorcyclists who own a road legal permitted motorbike, and they have to observe the road laws. The participation is at the participant's own risk and no liability can be assumed.

03. After the payment of the entry fee, the registration is valid. Payment address: MotorMedia GmbH, Europastrasse 15, CH-8152 Glattbrugg, Credit Suisse, Zürich, Clearing 4835, IBAN CH20 0483 5076 6728 3100 0; notation: „MSS Pass Crossing“. After receipt of payment the participants receive the necessary documents. You may also ask for a payment slip.

04. Entry fees are: for **MSS subscribers CHF 50.--**; **non-subscribers CHF 75.--**.

05. The scoring begins at **March 17th** and ends on **November 3rd, 2012**. During this period, participation is possible at any time.

06. The selection of mountain passes also as the time of crossing are free.

07. Only mountain passes which have been crossed in total can be scored (see list). Each mountain pass can be scored per tour and season only one time.

08. On the top of a mountain pass, the crossing has to be documented by a photo. The photo has to show the place name sign, the hospice or a typical feature. In addition, your motorbike also as the front-page of the MSS issue 6/12 has to be shown on the picture. Download of the front-page MSS 6/12: **www.motosport.ch** also as the map and the list of the mountain passes (can also be taken out from the middle of issue 06/12). Please mark at each entry or on each photo the relevant mountain pass number. **Note: we don't set control or time cards at disposal any more.**

10. The awarding of scores follows the points according to the mountain pass list in the regulations. The points for each mountain pass you can find here: **www.motosport.ch** or **www.motofun.ch** under „MSS Pass Crossing“. Control cards for your Pass Crossing can be downloaded under: **www.motofun.ch** and/or **www.motosport.ch**. With this tools, you can document your crossed mountain passes by PC or manually very easily.

11. The photos have to be sent until **November 3rd, 2012** (date stamp) to: Hermann Ryter, Erlenstrasse 47 B, CH-3612 Steffisburg; notation: „MSS Pass Crossing“. At the same address, you may also ask for control cards.

12. The awards will be given as follows:

„Gold medal“ 24'000 points and more

„Silver medal“ 12'000 to 23'999 points

„Bronze medal“ 6000 to 11'999 points or 20 mountain passes at the minimum

13. The award presentation ceremony will be held in the following year. The winners will be invited personally.
